Agnes Borowiak Prasatik 91, died on October 15, 2020 in Houston Hospice Hospital. She was born December 21, 1928 to Joseph Stanley Borowiak and Caroline Sebesta Borowiak. Agnes was married for sixty years to Leonard Lee Prasatik and worked with him throughout the 45 years he owned Prasatik Radio and Television in Rosenberg. Agnes was a devoted member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Rosenberg and attended regularly until the Corona Virus Pandemic. She enjoyed cooking for her family and for church social events. She and her husband traveled to Portugal, Bermuda, Jamaica, Las Vegas, and Arizona.

After her husband's death she was a regular participant in bingo games at the senior citizen center in Rosenberg, driving herself there until she was 89. She was a loyal and loving wife to her husband, Leonard, caring for him during the years he had Parkinson's disease. She was a devoted and caring mother to her son, Harold. Her children arise up and call her blessed; her husband also and he praiseth her."
