Funeral Mass for Alfred "Al" F. Becan, 76, of Rosenberg, will be held at 10:00 A.M., Thursday, August 27, 2009 at Holy Rosary Catholic Church, 1416 George Street in Rosenberg with Father William D. Bartniski officiating. Interment with military honors will follow at West Gethsemane Cemetery in Rosenberg.

Visitation will be held from 5:00 P.M. until 8:00 P.M., with a Rosary to be recited at 7:00 P.M., on Wednesday August 26, 2009 in the Chapel of Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Home in Rosenberg.

Al was born April 27, 1933 in Fort Worth to Joseph and Aloise Slovak Becan. He honorably served our country in the U.S. Army. He was a member of Holy Rosary Catholic Church. Al was a 4th Degree Knight of Columbus; a member of K.J.T., S.P.J.S.T. and American Legion Post #271. He coached Little League and loved to listen and dance to Polka music. Al and Vera enjoyed traveling to Louisiana for little excursions. He went to be with the Lord on Sunday, August 23, 2009 in Houston.
