This project was recognized in JAMA The Journal of the American Medical Association. She currently worked in a similar field at Memorial Hermann at Memorial City.

Alondra married her beloved husband, Mark Owen Trojacek, on August 16, 1983. They resided in Richmond, Texas where they raised three beautiful daughters.

Her interests include reading, camping, vacationing at the beach, gardening, decorating, singing, traveling, education, and spending time with her precious grandchildren.

She was a strong believer that anyone could succeed if given the chance. She touched the lives of those who knew and loved her.
