Funeral services for Alvin J. Blinka, Sr., 85, of Rosenberg, will be held at 10:00 A. M., Wednesday, December 22, 2010 at First Presbyterian Church in Rosenberg with Pastor Rhonda Detenbeck officiating. Interment will follow in Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg.
