Ann Lorraine DeWeese Blinka was born January 14, 1929 at home in Cunningham, Kansas to Oliver and Leona McMichael DeWeese. After a brief but brave fight with cancer she died at her home in Richmond on September 27, 2009.

Funeral services will be held 10 a.m. on October 1, 2009 in the Chapel of Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Home in Rosenberg. Interment will follow at Greenlawn Memorial Park. Pastor Norm Albertson will officiate. Visitation will be held 5 – 8 p.m., Wednesday September 30, at the Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel.
