Anton Ludwig Kostak was born in Waller, TX and he passed away on March 3rd at the age of 83. Anton was the son of Joseph C. Kostak and Kamila Rose Mikulenkakostak. Anton proudly served in the United States Army as a corporal during the Korean War. He met his wife, Eppie Ethel Mitcham at a family picnic. Their first date was at the Booth Trading Post in 1957 and they married a year later on August 2, 1958 in Frydek. Anton was employed with the Texas Highway Department for over 36 years as a lab technician building roads throughout the greater Fort Bend County area.
