



Aristeo Rocha Flores

September 3, 1924 - January 25, 2013

Aristeo Rocha Flores, loving family patriarch, and a longtime resident of Abilene, Texas peacefully passed away on Friday, January 25, 2013 in Missouri City Texas at the age of 88. He is preceded in death by his wife Vernarda Aguirre Flores and his parents Andres and Facunda Rocha, his adoptive father Jesus C. and Amelia Flores and brothers Emilio, Everardo. Aristeo was well regarded in the Hispanic Community in Abilene up until his wife's illness prompted a move to the Houston area to be near his children in 1996. He took a lot of joy and pride working for his Christian beliefs. He was a deacon for the Graham St. Church of Christ, and loved to deliver Sunday sermons when asked. He loved to translate English hymns into Spanish. He had very fond and loving memories for his church family, and many were saddened when he left Abilene.

Aristeo was always encouraging his children to get their education. His attempts to continue his education at Abilene Christian College were hindered by lack of transportation, since he had to walk to the campus from his home. In spite of his limited higher education friends and family members constantly sought him out when in need of assistance reading legal documents and other matters that required assistance.

Dad's deceased brother Reyes Flores was the second Abilene resident to have given his life in Viet Nam, and had a park in Abilene named in his honor. Aristeo was a constant supportive presence in the life of his father Jesus C. Flores an Abilene centenarian who died on July 4th 1984 at the age of 102.

Beloved "dad" "grandpa" will be very missed. Thank you, Dad, for you have touched the lives of many brothers and sisters in Christ.
