Arselle was not one for sitting indoors. She enjoyed working in the yard with her husband Gilbert and her grandchildren. When the yard work was done, they would spend their weekends camping in Boerne, Galveston, or on their property in Somerville, still towing the grandchildren with them.

She operated several salons in the southwest Houston retirement homes communities. Arselle made many friendships while working and was able to make them feel young and beautiful.
