Basilio S. Villalobos, 88, of Rosenberg, passed away at his home on February 24, 2024, surrounded by his loving family. He was born on July 28, 1935, in Fulshear, Texas to Loreto and Maria Villalobos.

More commonly known as “Chico”, he was a welder by trade but a true man of many talents – as witnessed by his family and friends throughout his years. 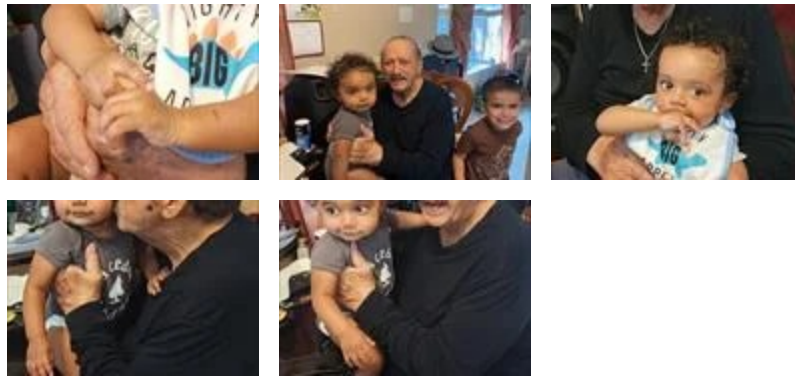
