



Beatrice Hilda Windsor

Beatrice Hilda Windsor, 93, of Magnolia, Texas, passed away on December 3, 2017. She was born in Lincoln, Texas on May 19, 1924. She was the widow of Raymond Luther Windsor, who passed in 2006. Beatrice was married to Raymond on July 15, 1939, and had ten children. She and Raymond shared marriage of 67 years. She is survived by her daughters, Mary Stebleton of Magnolia, Texas, and Joann Marks, with husband Geoffery Mart, of St. Johns, Florida, and her sons, Raymond, with wife Sandra of Paris, Texas, Norman, of Colorado, Chester, of Houston, Texas, Jimmy, with wife Barbara, of Conroe, Texas, and Jerry, with wife Joni, of Richmond, Texas. Sadly, three of her children preceded her in death, Carol Dawson, Beatrice Rose Eggert, and Richard Windsor.

Although a woman of many talents, her most endearing legacy is her 10 children, 23 grandchildren, 37 great grandchildren, and 23 great-great grandchildren, who all, at last count, numbered 93.

Beatrice and Raymond became members of Trinity Lutheran Church in downtown Houston back in the 1940's and several of their children attended Trinity School in the 1950's. After Beatrice was no longer able to attend

church services, she was strengthened by regular visits from Pastor Black and his associates until the week she joined our Lord in Heaven.

Services will be held at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Home, located at 3900 B. F. Terry Blvd, in Rosenberg, Texas. Visitation will be on Thursday, December 7th, from 5:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. Funeral services will start at 10:00 A.M. on Friday, December 8th. Beatrice will be buried in Rosenberg Cemetery next to her husband, Raymond, her daughter, Beatrice Eggert, and son, Richard Windsor.
