



## Beth Lovorn

May 15, 1957 - October 22, 2017

Beth La'Nae Lovorn of Rosenberg, Texas, passed away October 22, 2017 at the age of sixty. She was born in Munich, Germany, on May 15, 1957.

Beth is preceded in death by her father, Calvin Lovorn, and her sister, Robin Hull. She is survived by her life partner Martin Torres, mother, Della Lovorn of White Hall, Arkansas, brother, Marty Lovorn and brother-in-law, Frank Foster, of Highland Village, Texas, and niece "light of her life" Morgan Hull of Ann Arbor, Michigan.

Beth was a Baptist and a devoted educator. She moved to Rosenberg in 1986 and began teaching biology at Needville High School.
