A funeral mass for William Joseph "Bill" Sitka, 78, of Sugar Land, will be held at 10:00 a. m., Monday, October 8, 2012 at St. Theresa Catholic Church in Sugar Land. A graveside service will be held at 3:30 p. m. that afternoon in Sts. Cyril and Methodius Cemetery in Dubina, Texas.

Visitation will be held from 5:00 p. m. until 8:00 p. m., with a rosary being recited at 7:00 p. m., Sunday, October 7, 2012 at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg.

Bill was born February 28, 1934 in Hallettsville, Lavaca County, to Joe F. Sitka and Emma Kocian Sitka. He passed away October 3, 2012 in Houston. He served our country proudly in the U. S. Army. He was a member of St. Theresa Catholic Church in Sugar Land and it was there that he was involved with the Knights of Columbus Council #4204 and the Sugar Canes. He was also a member of the Fort Bend Czech Heritage Society, The Polka Lovers Klub of America, the Harris County Czech Singers and Honor Guard for the American Legion. He spent his entire career with Pipefitters Local Union 211.

Bill enjoyed life and everything it had to offer. First and foremost for him was his family, faith, friends and his farms. Bill loved the family gatherings which usually included many games of dominoes. He also loved attending his grandchildren's activities, polka dances and church bazaars. In his younger
