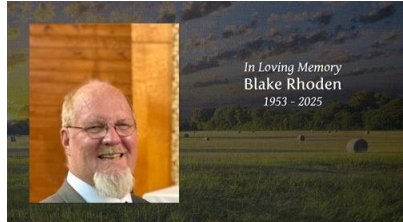
He was preceded in death by his parents, Lucile and Clifton Rhoden and in-laws, Johnnie and Doris Lev.
