Bobby was born April 11, 1934 in Baytown to Monroe Fletcher Davis and Myrtle Sparks Davis. He graduated from Missouri City High School and attended Abilene Christian College. He married Shirley Ann Clement on August 3, 1956. Bobby was employed by Gulf States Tube Corporation for 25 years beginning January 1956, throughout this time serving as an officer of Local Union #5754 of United Steelworkers of America. He then served 17 years as a Staff Representative for United Steelworkers of America. He was actively involved in the Democratic Party, receiving a Lifetime Achievement Award in 2006, which was presented by Fort Bend County. He passed away on March 12, 2013 in Rosenberg.
