Brady James Burris, 44, of Richmond, Texas passed away on December 8, 2023. He was born on July 31, 1979 in Houston, Texas to David and Nance (Becker) Burris. He honorably served our country as a Staff Sargent in the U.S. Air Force for 16 years, predominately in Pearl Harbor. He received the following medals: Joint Service Achievement, Joint Meritorious Unit Award, National Defense Service, Global War on Terrorism Service, Overseas Ribbon Long, and USAF NCO PME graduate and AF Training ribbons. He was also recognized for his work and outstanding contributions to the Defense Intelligence Agency in the Air and Air Defense Branch China Division. He was recognized in JICPAC of the Quarter for his high degree of personal achievement and dedication.

His hobbies included hiking, camping, cooking and spending time with family. He received his brown belt in Karate. He grew up loving the Karate Kid and watched million times.

If you were Brady's friend, you were his best friend. Although he will be missed dearly, the family is comforted knowing his mind, body and spirit have been set free.

Brady is preceded in death by his father, David Burris.
