Bruno Edward Nowak Sr. 79, passed away on February 22, 2021 and will be reunited in heaven with his loving wife of almost 50 years, Carol Jo King Nowak. He was born December 25, 1941 in Brenham to Bruno Tom Nowak and Geneve Dorothy Barnowski Nowak. Bruno graduated from Lamar High School and attended the University of Houston.
