Buddy Anderson was born on January 18, 1941 in Dennison, Texas and died on December 15, 2016 at OakBend Hospital in Richmond, Texas. He was preceded in death by his father Manual Anderson, mother, Jewel Webb Crowe and sister, Delores Durrance.
