Carmen was a member of the Rosenberg Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star #429 since 1959. She worked as a volunteer, with other Eastern Star ladies, for M.D. Anderson.

Carmen was well known by all her neighbors and their children. She babysat for friends and whenever there was a sick child, she took care of the child so the parent would not have to miss work. In times of sickness or death, Carmen was always there with a meal for the family.

Carmen will be remembered for her kindness, her love of family, her sweet smile and her delicious cooking.

Carmen was very faithful to her church and God blessed her in all she did. He has a most precious jewel with Him now. She will be dearly missed.
