Carol Mikeska Gubbels 85, of Thompson, Texas passed away peacefully on May 22, 2026. Carol was born on August 24, 1940, in Bellville, Texas to Robert and Lillian Mikeska. After twenty years as a homemaker, she entered the workforce as a senior plant chemist for Houston Lighting and Power Company. She was a devoted member of St. John Lutheran Church in Bellville but raised her family at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Richmond. Carol also enjoyed being a Cub Scouts Den Mother, sharing her knowledge and skills with many young men. She also served the town of Thompson for over 20 years on City Council, most of those as Mayor Pro-tempore. She was a Life Member of the Ft. Bend County Fair Assn. engaging in activities with the agricultural extension beekeeper group. This led Carol to become a member of the Texas Extension Education Association for 25 years earning Pecan Crop awards as well as project ribbons. Carol was a member of the Richmond Garden Club even after moving to Thompsons, frequently winning floral arrangement awards. Her interest in preservation led her to become a member of the Ft. Bend History Association. She was an avid outdoors woman who enjoyed gardening, fishing, hunting, and world traveling. She was deeply involved in the lives of her grandchildren and was always there for recitals, sporting events, and graduation. Grandma Carol was always ready to load up for brunches or birthdays with family.

Carol is preceded in death by her parents Lillian Hueske Mikeska and Robert Monroe Mikeska.
