A Funeral Mass for Celso Rodriguez, Jr., 82, of Stafford, Texas will be held at 11:00 A.M., Saturday, September 8, 2007 at St. Theresa Catholic Church in Sugar Land. Interment will follow at Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg.
