Funeral services for Charles Dudley Jarratt, 83, of Houston, will be held at 1:00 P. M., Monday, April 7, 2008 at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg with Jon Snider officiating. Interment will follow in Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg.
