February 15, 1948 - March 18, 2017

Charlotte Vickers Hall, age 69, passed away on Saturday March 18, 2017 due to complications from brain surgery on February 21, 2017.

Charlotte was born on February 15, 1948 in Cameron, TX. Her parents, James and Bernice, moved to Rosenberg in 1957 where she graduated from Lamar Consolidated High School in 1966.

During her work career she worked for the Houston Independent School District, the Houston Lighting and Power Company and ExxonMobil. During her career at ExxonMobil she worked in Controllers and Public Affairs. In the latter, she actively participated in and was recognized for her organizational skills in the setting up and coordinating ExxonMobil's many Blood Drives. In 1998, she was elected to the board of trustees of the Gulf Coast Regional Blood Center. Charlotte was also cited for achieving a personal blood contribution on 50 Gallons, thereby, saving many lives including her father's. Charlotte retired from ExxonMobil in 2012. In 2014, she joined the Women's Auxiliary of the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Post 3903, in Rosenberg. She is member of Peace Lutheran Church in Rosenberg.

Charlotte enjoyed going to Coushatta Casino Resort and gardening. She treasured the time spent with her family and watching their endeavors. Charlotte loved to cook and bake and was known for her exceptional pies, cookies and brownies. She eagerly awaited football season to start every year so she could root for her Houston Texans. This loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister and friend will be missed.

Charlotte is survived by her husband, James Hall; children, Leigh O'Leary and husband, Aaron and Kevin Street and wife, Deanna; sister, Barbara Bryan and husband, Joe; proud Grandma to Ethan, Liam, Mason and Ivy; along with a host of extended family and friends.
