Chris was a Sergeant in the Texas Army National Guard, assigned to Delta Company , 1st Battalion, 149th Aviation, Ellington Field. Veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedom 2005-2006 stationed in Balad/Basrah. He operated Apache Weapons Armament Systems on helicopters. His achievements were: Army Achievement Medal 2nd, Army Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Global War on Terrorism Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Ribbon, Armed Forces Reserve Medal w/ M Device and the USA Aviator Badge.
