Christopher "Chris" Louis Cooke, 52, of Richmond, Texas, experienced sudden cardiac arrest and passed away at home on May 18, 2023. Chris was born in Fort Sill, Oklahoma, on July 2, 1970, to Colonel (Ret.) Harold and Betty Cooke. He was a graduate of Lawton High School and Texas A&M University, where he was a member of the Corps of Cadets, Company I-1.
