Curtis Dean Selberg, formerly of Waukon and Decorah, Iowa, passed away peacefully in his home in Rosenberg, Texas on March 20, 2018 following illness.

Curt was born on the Selberg family farm near Waukon on December 20, 1938 to parents Walter H. and Vivian (Kurth) Selberg. He received his grade school education at Ludlow #3, a one-room country school. In 1956, Curt graduated from Waukon High School. The following year he married Marjorie Nolting. Their marriage was blessed with three sons, Mark, Brad, and Brian. They were later divorced.
