Daymond David Mayhall, 88, of Missouri City, Texas passed away on June 11, 2020. He was born on December 11, 1931 in Port Lavaca, Texas. A funeral Mass will be held at St. Laurence Catholic Church in Sugar Land, Texas on Thursday, June 18, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. His ashes will be interred at the Houston National Cemetery in a private family service.
