Denver "Mac" Earl McFarland, 91, of Rosenberg, Texas passed away on April 14, 2017 in Richmond. He was born in Lynn, Indiana on April 26, 1925, the eighth child of William Frank and Laura (Bane) McFarland. He honorably served our country, first in the U.S. Army during World War II. He was at the invasion of Normandy. After World War II, he left the army and went back home to Indiana. He then realized that he wanted to serve our country more so he joined the U.S. Air Force where he served in the Korean War. He received two Purple Hearts along with other numerous medals. After the military, he eventually worked for Duval Sulfur and Pennzoil where he retired from. Wherever Mac went he always made friends. He always had a joke, and he never could take a serious picture. Mac was a member of St. John's United Church of Christ in Rosenberg where he loved its fellowship. His hobbies included deer hunting, watching wrestling, going to the farm in Fairchild, dancing, and doing word search puzzles.

Mac is survived by: his loving wife of 17 years, Marie McFarland; son, Dale McFarland and wife Delta; grandchildren, Steven McFarland and wife Rebecca, Elizabeth Andel and husband Tim; great grandchildren, Emilie Andel, Eli and Sadie McFarland. The family grew when he married Marie which included her children Rita, Randy, Ricky, and Larry Boudoin and numerous grandchildren and great grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, Mac is preceded in death by his 1st wife, Elsie Hluchanek McFarland; five brothers and two sisters.
