Diana Linda Valchar, 74, of Rosenberg, Texas, passed away on Friday, June 14, 2024.

Diana was the youngest of five siblings born to Leopold and Helen {Stavinoha} Valchar on August 22, 1949.

Diana grew up in a devout Catholic household, and upon graduation from Needville High School, she began a career as a telephone operator for Southwestern Bell that later became AT&T.
