Douglas Cary Finch, 74, of Houston, Texas passed away on January 3, 2024. He was born on December 17, 1949, in Richmond, Texas to Newell Finch Jr. and Helen Eleanor (Rogge) Finch. He graduated from Lamar Consolidated High School in 1968, where he played four years on the football team. Following high school, he attended Wharton County Junior College before enlisting in the US Army, where he served from 1971 to 1975. During his military service, Douglas excelled as a paratrooper with the 82nd Airborne Division, underwent jungle training in Panama, and worked as a mechanic in the motor pool. Notably, he achieved the highest score on the army mechanical aptitude test during that period. Douglas' passion for mechanical work emerged early in life, leading him to become the proud owner and operator of Finch's Alternator & Starter Rebuilders in Houston. Outside of his professional endeavors, Douglas cherished moments spent fishing, hunting, and enjoying the outdoors. This loving son, father, grandfather, brother, uncle, and friend will be missed.

Douglas is preceded in death by his father, Newell Finch Jr. and his nephew, Scott Thomas Wilkins.
