Dr. Byron W. Baker, of Richmond, passed away March 1, 2012. "Doc" departed this earth peacefully to join his Savior, Jesus Christ and his wife, Shirley Baker. He was born in 1932 in Houston. Doc graduated from the University of Texas Dental School and practiced dentistry in Houston for over 50 years.

Doc is survived by his brother, Dr. John Baker and family of Houston; children, Khrisana and Michael Edwards of Austin; Pamela Gleason of Wake Forest, North Carolina and Mike Martin of Houston; seven grandchildren; and loved caregivers, Osby Thompson and Mary Varela. His list of beloved friends is countless.

He is preceded in death by his wife, Shirley Baker; and sons, Steven and David.

Doc's great love was music - "real" country music. For many years he led a band that performed in and around the Houston area. He developed a close relationship with Ernest Tubb and Ernest went on to record Doc's original song, "Who's Gonna Be Your Santa Claus This Year". Doc twice performed on stage at the Grande Ole Opry in Nashville, TN.

Doc enjoyed his afternoon coffee discussing politics, great literature and

music, and the travails of being a Houston sports fan. He lived each day to the fullest.

A memorial service to celebrate Doc's life will be held at 10 a.m., Tuesday, March 6, 2012 at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg.
