April 8, 1924 - December 23, 2010

A Funeral Mass for Edwin "Tac" Hrncir, 86, of Richmond, will be held at 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, December 28, 2010 at Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Rosenberg with Father Bill Bartniski celebrating the funeral mass and rite of committal. Interment will follow in Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg.

Visitation will be held 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., with a rosary at 7:00 p.m., Monday, December 27 at Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Rosenberg.

Edwin was a member of the Knights of Columbus and served 64 years. He was Grand Knight of Council 2801 in Rosenberg on two occasions and served repeatedly as recruitment chairman, trustee, and retention chairman. He also served as District Deputy 1986-1989 and as Texas State Warden 1989-1991. He served as the 4th degree Master of the First District 1977-1980. His hobby was grafting pecan trees & grafted many pecan trees in Fort Bend County. He also participated in the pecan shows with the Extension Service. He also was learning to graft citrus trees. He worked for HL&P Co. for 36 years as a Lineman. He also served in the Army from 1942-1943. Dad loved hunting, fishing, and all sports, especially the Astros.

Edwin was born April 8, 1924 in Hallettsville, Texas to John Hrcir and Emilie Sciba Hrcir. He passed away Thursday, December 23, 2010 in Richmond.

He is preceded in death by his wife, Iris Lee Russell Hrcir; parents, John and Emilie Hrcir; sisters, Anita Jakubik and Janie Jakubik; and brother, Otto Hrcir.
