



Elizabeth Wyche Stevenson Robison

July 21, 1917 - January 2, 2007

Elizabeth Wyche Stevenson Robison went to be with her Lord on January 2, 2007. She was born July 21, 1917 in Longview, TX. She lived her early years in Longview, graduating as Valedictorian of Longview High School in 1934. From there she entered SMU on an academic scholarship and later transferred to the University of Texas. She graduated UT in 1938 with a B.A. in English with High Honors. While at SMU, she was initiated into Zeta Tau Alpha sorority and maintained a lifetime membership. After graduating from UT she worked in the Secretary of State's office in Austin until marrying Hal C. Stevenson, Jr. on April 5, 1941. Theirs was the first wedding in the newly renovated First Presbyterian Church in downtown Longview. Elizabeth taught third grade in the Houston public schools for twenty years, all at Mark Twain Elementary. She was a lifetime member of the Captain William Young Chapter of the DAR. She lived in Houston from 1952-1981 and moved to Lake Cherokee in 1981. Elizabeth's first husband, Hal, died in 1983, and in 1986 she married B.A. Robison, to whom she had been engaged before she met and married Hal C. Stevenson. Her second husband, B.A. Robison, died, January, 2003. Since that time Elizabeth resided at Colonial Oaks in Sugar Land, TX. She was preceded in death by her parents, Reagan and Martine Wyche, her brother Jimmy Wyche, and both her husbands. She is survived by children, Hal C. Stevenson, III, and wife, Brenda; Janie Stevenson Watson and husband, Jeff; step-children Ardis Robison and wife Suzee, Wendall Robison and wife Kay, Catherine Patton and husband, Jimmy, and Patty Braud and husband, Scott; grandchildren, Beth Ollre and husband, Doug, Tracey Flessner and husband, Lance, Jim Rombough, David Rombough and Olga Rombough; seven great-grandchildren, along with other family members and friends.
