



## Elton Loren Reynolds

January 21, 1920 - March 15, 2018

Elton Loren Reynolds, 98, of Rosenberg peacefully passed away on March 15, 2018. He was born into the family of William “Willie” Ellsworth and Addie Hamlink Reynolds on January 21, 1920 in Beasley. He graduated from Beasley High School in 1938. Shortly thereafter he moved to Houston, began working for Weingarten’s grocery store, and then joined the US Navy Reserve. On September 1, 1940 Elton married Eleanor Holt. The following year in May 1941, he was called to active duty. He served as Chief Commissary Steward on the LST US 1021 during WWII. After receiving an honorable discharge in 1945, he moved to Hot Springs, Arkansas, where his daughter Gail was later born. In 1947 Elton moved back to Rosenberg to start his own business, a radiator shop. In 1953 his second child, Michael, was born. Elton left his own business to join Allied Concrete in 1961. On August 31, 1974, he married Helen Juengerman. He retired as Vice President of Allied Concrete in 1979. Elton was active in Jaycees, Rosenberg-Richmond Chambers, and Rosenberg Lion’s Club. He was a member of Holy Rosary Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus #7445, and the Fort Bend Beekeepers Association, serving as president for many years. As a beekeeper, Elton could often be seen in classrooms or county fairs proudly displaying his observational hive and teaching the youth about bees.

He was preceded in death by his parents; first wife, Eleanor; sisters, Mary Look, Cora Kennon, and Gladys Meyer; brother, Virgil Reynolds; sister-in-law, Ida Reynolds; brother-in-laws, Sonny Look, Drew Kennon, and Ed Meyer; and

son, Michael "Mikey" Juengerman. He is survived by his loving wife, Helen; daughter, Gail and her husband, Roger Adams; son, Michael and his wife, Regene Reynolds; daughter, Marilyn "Toodie" and her husband, Mark Sitka; and son, James "Jimmy" Juengerman; along with 7 grandchildren and numerous great grandchildren.

Elton faithfully served his country, family and fellow man without waver even up until his final moments. We should only be so lucky to follow his footsteps and have such a full, loving life.

Funeral services will be held Monday morning, March 19, 2018 at 10:00 A.M. in the Chapel at Davis Greenlawn Funeral Home with burial to follow in Greenlawn Memorial park. Visitation will be Sunday, March 18, 2018 from 3-5 P.M. with a Rosary at 4:00 P.M.
