Ernest William Stokey passed away on July 7, 2023 at the age of 96. He was born on August 4, 1926 in Houston, Texas to Bertram and Mary Stokey. He was predeceased by his parents and brother Bert Stokey, and his wife, Frankie Stokey.

He worked at an early age by bagging groceries, operating a paper route with his brother for the Houston Post and working as a steno at the Burlington Rhode Island Railroad Company. His work ethic carried over into his adult working career included working in the oil industry, construction, business machine sales, and road repair. He didn't retire until he reached the age of 90. He was a member of St. John's United Methodist Church in Richmond, Texas for 30 years.
