



Eugene "Gene" Allen Borak

October 29, 1933 - March 18, 2017

Eugene 'Gene' Allen Borak of Rosenberg, ascended into heaven on March 18, 2017 after a long fight with Alzheimer's. Gene was born in Mart, Texas on October 29, 1933 to Julie Wasek Borak, and Adolph Borak. Gene graduated from Mart High School, and North Texas State University, where he was a member of Delta Sigma Phi. Following the completion of his degree, he was drafted in the Army where he served his country for 2 years, spending time in Germany, after which he was honorably discharged. He met the love of his life, Viola Louise Kubena, and married her in October, 1958. Together they had four children. Gene worked hard to provide for his family at Gray Tool Company (and eventually Vetco Gray) for 38 years. After retirement, he was a substitute teacher at various schools in the Lamar CISD schools, where he most enjoyed the Special Education classrooms.

Gene raised his children to be responsible, loving and giving. He taught by example as an active volunteer with Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Lamar 4-H, Fort Bend County Fair and the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo, and American Legion. He was Cub Master, 4-H Leader, served on the Board for Fort Bend County Fair, for which he was president in 1980, and actively served for 30 years on Calf Scramble, then Horse Show Committees for HLSR. Gene had a love for the land and his animals always, he spent his free time with his hands in the dirt gardening, working with his cows or caring for his dogs. His final volunteer efforts with the American Legion Honor Guard were cut short by the effects of Alzheimer's.

Gene can best be remembered for his giving spirit, his love to twirl his wife on the dance floor, and his love for his family and friends. He was preceded in death by his mother Julia, father Adolph, brother Edward, and beloved dogs Sassy and Sugar. He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Viola, his children Eugene Jr and wife Sandy, Ronald and wife Monica, Cindy Istre and husband Noah, and Lisa Bisceglia; grandchildren Kristopher Landers and wife Lauren, Jennifer Tondera and husband Danny, Melissa and Justin Borak, and McCale and Katrina Fite; and four great grandchildren; Liam and Kynna Landers, Kaydence and Allie Tondera, and beloved dog Mollie.

Visitation at Greenlawn is scheduled for Monday, March 20th from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., with Rosary at 7:00pm. Funeral services will be at Holy Rosary Catholic Church, in Rosenberg on Tuesday, March 21st at 10:00 a.m., followed by burial at Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg.
