Eugene F. Ling was born in Flatonia, Texas as the son of Frederick Joseph Ling and Hattie Rabe Ling on June 9, 1931. He later moved with his family to Schulenburg, Texas where he graduated from Schulenburg High School. On June 9, 1952, he married Georgie Novak. Eugene was inducted into the United States Army in December and after serving in the United States and Korea, he received his honorable discharge in El Paso, Texas.
