September 27, 1935 - November 2, 2015

Floryian W. Kendziora, 80, passed away November 2, 2015 in Richmond. He was born September 27, 1935 in Richmond to the late William Kendziora and Victoria Nowak Kendziora. He attended Lamar High School. On April 4, 1959, he married Ruth Hedt of Needville. He was a life-long member of Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Rosenberg. Floryian served his country in France as a military policeman in the U.S. Army in the 1950's.

He was employed by the Fort Bend County Drainage District; served as Assistant Water Superintendent for the City of Rosenberg, and was a gradall operator for Fort Bend County, Precinct 1, for 28 years, having retired in 1994. Beginning in 1973 he was also a farmer and rancher.

He was a devoted husband, father and grandfather. He enjoyed taking the grandchildren to the farm and giving them rides on the tractor or letting them bottle feed a calf. He also enjoyed gambling trips to Louisiana.

He was preceded in death by his parents, step-mother, Veronica Kendziora; brothers, Ed, Louis, Bill and Steve Kendziora; sisters, Lillie Bukowsky and Florence Sykowski and step-sister, Leonarda Mazurkiewicz.

Floryian is survived by his loving wife, Ruth, of 56 years; his daughter, Shirley Kendziora of Katy, his son, David Kendziora of Richmond, as well as

grandchildren, Brandon, Kaitlyn and Hannah Kendziora, sisters; Julia Faterkowski of Wharton and Cecilia Fuchs and husband Wilburn of Needville and half-brother, John Kendziora and wife Nancy of Needville and a host of loving nieces, nephews, cousins and other family and friends.

Funeral services will be held Friday, November 6, 2015 at 2:00 P.M. at Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Rosenberg with Father Bill Bartniski officiating. Burial will follow in Greenlawn Memorial Park.
