



Floyd L. Seiler

January 5, 1928 - December 6, 2010

Funeral services for Floyd L. Seiler, 82, of Pearland will be 2 p.m., Friday, December 10, 2010 in the Chapel of Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Home in Rosenberg with interment following at Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg. Reverend Chris Norton and Mr. Don Seiler will officiate the services.

Visitation will be held 4 p.m. until 7 p.m., Thursday, December 9, 2010 at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg.

Floyd was born January 5, 1928 in Needville to Albert Edward and Julia Ida Schuelke Seiler. He attended the Seiler School and Richmond High School where he graduated in 1946. Floyd went on to serve our country in the U.S. Air Force and retired as a Chief Master Sergeant. He was the Avionics lead on the team that established the Trans-Continental speed record in 1948. Floyd was a project manager with the Space Program from the first Apollo mission through the Space Shuttle. He went on to be Vice President of Taft Broadcasting Company where he retired in 1988. Floyd was a member of Pearland Methodist Church, Air Force Sergeant's Association and the American Legion. He passed away December 6, 2010 in Houston.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Albert and Julia Seiler; two brothers, W.E. "Bill" Seiler and Leroy Seiler; and a sister, Mildred Seiler.

Floyd is lovingly survived by his wife of 60 years, Martha N. Seiler; children, Donald Wayne Seiler and wife, Bobbye, Vicki Norton and husband, Chris, Cindy Edge and husband, Dennis, Karen Saye and husband, David Mraz, and Brian Seiler and wife, Tammy; 15 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren; along with numerous other relatives and friends.
