



## Frances Rodriguez Luna

Frances Rodriguez Luna, 87, of Rosenberg, Texas passed away on May 15, 2024, surrounded by her loving family. She was born on April 10, 1937, in Richmond, Texas to Elias and Frances Rodriguez.

Frances retired from the U.S. Customs Service after 38 years and was a member of the National Active & Retire Federal Employees (NARFE). She was also involved with the Ft. Bend Interfaith Council and the League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC). She was a life-time member of Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church in Rosenberg where she served on several committees including President of the Pastoral Council and serving as a Lector for 30 years. Frances was also a lifetime member of the V.F.W. Ladies Auxiliary #3903, and a Member of the Business & Prof. Organization. (B.P.W.).

Frances was also very active with the Ft. Bend County Toastmasters, Happy Cousins Dance Club, Business & Professional Women's Club and the Ft. Bend Lioness Clubs.
