Sunday morning, October 24, 2021, Francis "Frank" Joseph Peters entered the gates of heaven to be with his Lord and Savior while at his home in Richmond, Texas. Frank, 80, was born on December 15, 1940 in Pocatello, Idaho to Joe and Leola Peters. Frank married his most loving companion, Mary Kay (Wagner), on January 5, 1974. Together, they enjoyed life to the fullest and were each other's number one fans. They spent their 48 years traveling, raising kids, and sharing the love of Jesus wherever they went.

Frank attended Palmer Chiropractic College in Davenport, Iowa and graduated with a Doctorate of Chiropractic Degree from Texas Chiropractic College in 1970. For 45 years in his Amarillo practice, Frank was very active as a chiropractor, using his hands to serve, help, and pray over his patients.

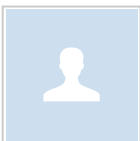
