Funeral services for Francis R. Glasser, 79, of Wharton, Texas, formerly of Sugar Land, will be held at 10 a.m., Saturday, May 21, 2011 at St. John's Catholic Church in Hungerford. Interment will follow at Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg. Father Charles Dwomoh will officiate the services.

Visitation will be held from 5 p.m. until 8 p.m., with a rosary at 7 p.m., Friday, May 20, 2011 at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg.

Francis was born April 2, 1932 in Geddes, SD to William George and Ida Mae Gass Glasser. He married Ann Jane Talafuse, a polio victim, in 1958. Francis was a loving and supportive husband and caregiver and raised his two sons and was a giving, caring and loving husband, for 49 years until her death in 2008. He served in the U.S. Air Force in Korea in 1953 and S.E. Asia from 1968 - 1969 and retired after 20 years of service with the rank of Tech Sgt.. Francis then worked at Imperial Sugar for 25 years. He was an avid gardener and fisherman. Francis passed away May 19, 2011 in Wharton.

He is preceded in death by his wife, Ann Jane Talafuse; parents, George and Ida Glasser; sister, Patti Blair; and brother, Martin Glasser.
