Services to celebrate the life of Gene Eldon Frank, 44, of Rosenberg will be held at 2:00 P.M., Tuesday, July 21, 2009 at Church of Living Waters, 4808 Airport Avenue in Rosenberg. Interment will follow at the Rosenberg City Cemetery, formerly W.O.W. Cemetery, in Rosenberg. Dr Gene W. Frank, Pastor Darren Frank, Pastor Mike Richards, and Pastor Robert Ashley will officiate the services.

Visitation will begin at 6:00 P.M., Monday, July 20, 2009 at Church of Living Waters in Rosenberg.

Gene was born November 22, 1964 in Richmond, to Gene W. and Betty Jo Ashley Frank. He graduated from Terry High School, Class of 1983. Gene enjoyed hunting, fishing and being outdoors. To say he was an avid University of Texas Longhorn fan was an understatement. He passed away July 16, 2009 at his home in Rosenberg.
