



## Geneva Lane

August 13, 1926 - December 31, 2018

Geneva Lane of Rosenberg, Texas, age 92, passed away Monday December 31, 2018 at Silverado Memory Care in Sugar Land, Texas. She was born Katherine Geneva Mehrens on August 13, 1926 in Markham, Texas to Ben and Nahomie Mehrens. Geneva was the youngest of 9 siblings. As the daughter of a rancher and rice farmer, her family moved frequently during her childhood. She attended schools in Markham, Bay City, El Campo, Rosenberg and Richmond. Geneva met James Lane on a blind date in 1947, while she worked as a doctor's assistant and he worked at his father's Hudson dealership in Rosenberg. They were married at her parent's home on Carlisle St. on December 8, 1948. James and Geneva made their home in Rosenberg where she began working as a bookkeeper in their family business of Lane Motor Company. They became members of the Church of Christ in Rosenberg in the early 1950's. Geneva was an active and supportive elder's wife in the church for many years. Her greatest joy was received from time spent with her grandchildren whether it was playing board games, reading books, doing crafts or attending their school activities. Throughout her life she enjoyed gardening, china painting and antique collecting. She especially enjoyed opening her home for gatherings of family and church friends.

Geneva was preceded in death by her parents, Ben and Nahomie Mehrens; sisters, Lela Mae Ansel, Lola Mehrens, Leona Barnett, Beatrice Bailey and Irene Zumwalt; and brothers, Clarence Mehrens, Jack Mehrens and her twin
