George "Larry" Anderson Sr. passed away peacefully on April 24, 2025 at the age of 85.

Larry Anderson was born February 13, 1940 in Missouri City, Texas to Quincy Wilburn Anderson and Ottis Lee (Law) Anderson. Larry Anderson grew up as a patriotic Texan/American, hard worker, and a devote family man that was experienced by everyone who touched his life.

Larry graduated from Lamar High School. He received an honorable discharge in 1966 from the Army of the United States. He married Doris Enelda (Urena) Anderson on January 5, 1964 in Panama City Canal Zone, Panama. Larry later graduated from Houston Community College May 16, 1976.

Larry dedicated his career to the water works industry starting at Municipal Pipe and Supply (later Western Pipe and Supply Company) and then Kennedy Valve Company achieving many accolades as an outside Salesman and Regional Manager which then encouraged him to start Geo-Glen Enterprises, Inc. at the age of 52. Geo-Glen Enterprises, Inc has grown tremendously from a start up in his garage into the company we know today.

Larry enjoyed traveling with his family deer watching with his wife on their

property. Those who knew Larry remember him for his mechanical and innovative mind; he had a unique way of assessing a situation and developing working solutions. Larry played golf with his two boys whenever he had the chance.

He is survived by his wife Doris E. Anderson, sons George Larry Anderson Jr. (Leslie) and Ronald Glenn Anderson, sister Mamie Lucas (David) and brother John Buckley Anderson (Lynn), and grandchild Zev Alarik Anderson.
