Georgia Vlasta Sbrusch, 96, of Beasley, Texas passed away on Sunday, January 18, 2009 in Sealy, Texas. She was born in Hallettsville, Texas on November 9, 1912, to John and Sophia Chudej. On October 26, 1935, she married Willie Sbrusch in St. Wenceslaus Catholic Church in Beasley, Texas.

Visitation will be from 5:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M., on Tuesday, January 20, 2009 with a rosary at 7:00 P.M. at Davis Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg.

Funeral mass will be held at 2:00 P.M., Wednesday, January 21, 2009 at St. Wenceslaus Catholic Church in Beasley with burial in the St. Wenceslaus Cemetery in Beasley to follow. Fathers Henry Rachunek and Eric Pitre will officiate the services.

Willie and Georgia lived almost all of their 73 year marriage on their farm in Beasley. She worked side-by-side with Willie in the office at the Ft. Bend Tractor and Implement Company which they owned and operated for many years. She also worked at the Sugar Refinery in Sugarland with three of her sisters, and for twenty-five years at Schaffer's Pharmacy in Rosenberg. Georgia was a loving and caring wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother. She was always there for her children and always did the very best she could to nurture her family. As a farmer's wife, she was always prepared for company. Her freezer and canning pantry were always stocked

with kolaches, cookies and homemade jellies and vegetables. Christmas and birthdays meant a gallon of their favorite cookies for each family member. She was never happier than when she had family over for a meal.

Georgia served thirteen years as a county 4H leader teaching girls how to sew in workshops held during the summers at Needville High School. She also chaperoned trips and campouts for the county 4H'ers and served as a food judge at the Ft. Bend County Fair and Needville Youth Fair. She was a member of St. Wenceslaus Catholic Church, St. Anne's Altar Society, and KJZT. She was a member of the church choir for many years.

Georgia is preceded in death by her parents John and Sophia Chudej, her infant son Robert Sbrusch, great granddaughter Lindsey Fagert, sisters Emma Sykora, Willie Mae Pruess, Edith Webb, twin sister Henrietta Dobesh, and brother Julius Chudej.
