Georgie Ann Bosak, 81, passed away on Friday, April 24, 2015 at her home in Needville, Texas. She was born in Richmond, Texas on October 31, 1933 to Johnnie and Vlasta Baca. She attended school in Richmond, and then Needville High School where she was the first drum major and a cheerleader. She was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church, the American Legion Ladies Auxillary, Unit 350, and the Needville Fire Department Auxillary. She volunteered with the Needville Youth Fair, Harvest Festival, Senior Citizens and the S.P.J.S.T. nursing home.
