



## Gilbert J. Walzel

January 28, 1924 - February 5, 2018

Gilbert J. Walzel, 94, long-time resident of Needville, Texas passed away on February 5, 2018. He was born January 28, 1924 in Wallis, Texas to Ernest H. and Stephina (Hlavaty) Walzel. He graduated from Beasley High School and was a mechanic by trade. Gilbert was a past Shop Foreman at Rosenberg Ford and past owner of Walzel's Garage, Jeep Sales and Wrecker Service. His hobbies included hunting, traveling, ranching, and playing Dominoes. He and his wife of 73 years, the late Benita Walzel, enjoyed being members of the Needville, Rosenberg, Industry, Sealy and Wallis Dance Clubs.
