



Gloria (Astorga) Perez

November 12, 1944 - March 15, 2018

Gloria Astorga Perez, 73, affectionately known as “YaYa”, passed away on Thursday, March 15, 2018 at her home in Rosenberg with her family by her side. Gloria was born on November 12, 1944 in Sugar Land, Texas to Ysidro and Bruna Astorga.
