It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Helen Regina Baca Miller, a remarkable woman whose life touched the hearts of all who knew her. Helen departed from this world on August 27, 2023, leaving behind a legacy of unwavering compassion and tenacity. Though her physical presence may be gone, those she has touched will remember her profound kindness.

Born on February 20, 1949, in East Bernard, TX, Helen embodied the essence of unconditional love and selflessness from the beginning. As a daughter, sister, and friend, she consistently demonstrated a remarkable capacity to care for others, always putting their needs before her own. In addition to her caring nature, tenacity was one of her defining characteristics. She faced life's challenges head-on, refusing to be discouraged by obstacles in her path. She held positions with St. Edwards University, Exxon USA, EPRCo., Texas Department of Commerce, Texas Engineering Experiment Station, National Center for Manufacturing Sciences, and the Society of Manufacturing Engineers.

As a wife, Helen was an anchor to her husband Ed, and a source of unwavering support for him. In his words, she saved him and took care of him through all of life's trials and triumphs. Upon retiring, they moved to White

Spring, FL, where she became the mayor and they endeavored to give back to the town. As partners, they developed and organized the Helping Our People Excel (H.O.P.E) programs in White Springs, which delivered education and community services to at-risk youth and their families. These services included the HOPE summer and after-school programs, teen internships, adult and community education, and a fuel bank for low-income families. She volunteered her time and resources selflessly, embodying the true spirit of generosity. She had an innate ability to bring people together to support those most in need and, without a doubt, will leave indelible mark on those children's lives. Her acts of kindness and compassion touched countless lives, and her legacy of giving back will continue to inspire others.

As a stepmom, she was a patient listener who could tend to a skinned knee as easily as she could discuss approaches to completing a difficult assignment for school. In support of her children's sporting endeavors, she volunteered much of her time fundraising for Huron High School Athletics. Her children will cherish their time together and be grateful for the love they shared.

To her siblings, Helen was not only a sister but also a caretaker and a pillar of strength. She embraced the role of being their protector, listener, and source of guidance. They will forever carry her memory as a source of strength and comfort.

Helen is survived by her devoted husband, Edward Miller. Her 5 children Brandon Miller, Ryan Miller, Candance Marzban, Kirsten Weber, and Todd Miller, and 8 grandchildren.

She also leaves behind her three brothers, Leo Baca, Jim Baca, and Larry Baca, as well as their spouses and many nieces and nephews. Helen was predeceased by her Mother Olga Baca Uhyrek, Father Leo Baca, and her

stepdad August Uhyrek.
