



## Herman B. Pospisil

August 5, 1933 - October 9, 2013

A funeral mass will be held for Herman B. Pospisil, 80, of Rosenberg, Texas at 10 a.m., Monday, October 14, 2013 at Holy Rosary Catholic Church in Rosenberg. Interment will follow at Greenlawn Memorial Park in Rosenberg.

Visitation will be from 4 p.m. until 8 p.m., with a rosary at 6 p.m., Sunday, October 13, 2013 at Davis-Greenlawn Funeral Chapel in Rosenberg.

Herman was born August 5, 1933 in Flatonia to Bennie Franklin and Willie Mae Haddock Pospisil. He was a member of Holy Rosary Catholic Church. Herman was an honorary life member Grand Knight of the Knights of Columbus, council #2801 and an honorary life member 4th Degree Knight and past Faithful Navigator for Knights of Columbus, Assembly #1114.
